

2. VOLUNTARY ADVISORY MISSIONS

We are also developing a voluntary advisory mission program. In this program, we will deploy a volunteer advisor to advise you on particular safety related challenges that you come across in your organisation. The volunteer advisor will help you identify options to address the safety challenge you are facing and help develop your organisation's resourcefulness to address it.

We currently can deploy voluntary advisory missions on Air Navigation Service Provider certification and just culture development. We will broaden the areas of expertise in the coming period.

The first mission is included in your Friendship support but you can access more voluntary advisory missions for a small fee.

Our volunteer advisors will need to be paid a daily allowance for their days of deployment with you plus their travel days.

The voluntary advisory mission will be governed by a contract and an invoice.

The table below provides clarity on the set up of those missions.

1. MENTORING PROGRAM
